The UNday project is back for its second year conducting a manifestation with children and young people on the UN Day October 24, 2012. This time students from **Sct Jörgen's school in Holstebro**, Denmark, pupils from World Heritage Göthrik's school, Varberg, Sweden, the regional Teater Halland, artists and the World Heritage Grimeton Radio Station collaborate for a new manifestation sent to the world.

This year's campaign is a manifestation during which **pupils are making their voices heard for a few hours, sending messages, videos and audio over the internet to the world, people, policy makers and the future!** Last year's manifestation was transmitted over the internet and by long wave, and was downloaded in **800 locations worldwide**, as well as by radio amateurs.

- Welcome to the UN Day and the UNday project and a streamed/live online broadcast directly from World Heritage Grimeton Radio Station
- Start of the radio station's unique long wave transmitter, called SAQ
- The pupil's image -and audio manifestations are streamed over the internet
- Messages are sent over long wave with morse code over the world!

Your students can interact and comment on the transmission via the website and blog. We invite you to prepare and send your own "UNday project messages" to the world. Everyone who gets involved with the UNday project gets a certificate for his or her participation in the UN Day celebration on October 24 2012.
